SUBJECT: Command Policy Memorandum #12, Imagery/Photography Activities at the Presidio of Monterey (POM) and Ord Military Community (OMC)

1. References:

- a. 50 U.S.C. §797, Penalty for Violation of Security Regulations and Orders, as amended.
- b. 18 U.S.C. §793, Gathering, Transmitting or Losing Defense Information, as amended.
- c. DA msg, 241751Z Mar 08, subject: ALARACT – Prohibition on Commercial Image Collection and Surveillance.
- d. AR 190-13, The Army Physical Security Program, 25 February 2011.
- e. AR 360-1, The Army Public Affairs Program, 25 May 2011.

2. Purpose: To establish POM policy and procedures for photography and videography activities on POM and OMC. Providing for the defense of military installations in a post-9/11 environment is of the highest concern. Commanders have the responsibility and the authority (1.a.) to enforce appropriate security measures to ensure the protection of DoD property and personnel assigned, attached or subject to their Command. The purpose of this policy is to balance the security needs of this installation with the freedoms of those living, serving and enjoying recreational or command events. Good judgment and common sense should always be applied to any situation.

3. Applicability: This policy applies to all persons entering, assigned to, in temporary duty status at or employed on POM and OMC and their dependents/guests on the installation. Violation of this policy may subject the individual to adverse administrative action and punishment under the UCMJ. Individuals found violating this policy may be barred from further entry onto the installation.

4. Proponent: The proponent for this policy letter is the Directorate of Plans, Training, Mobilization and Security (DPTMS) Antiterrorism Officer, 831-242-7027.

5. The following are not permitted on POM or OMC without prior authorization of the Garrison Commander (GC) or designated representative (route through DPTMS: Antiterrorism and/or Operations Security Officer):

- a. No commercial photography, videography or global positioning surveys.
 - b. No photographing or videotaping by anyone of defense facilities (1.b.), specifically of critical facilities, designated restricted areas, High Risk Targets (HRTs), Access Control Points; to include the vehicle search areas and Mission Essential/Vulnerable Areas (MEVAs) (Check with AT Officer or Physical Security Officer 831-242-7733).
 - c. No photographing and videotaping of Child Development Centers (CDC) , Child Youth School Services (CYSS) and other Morale, Welfare, and Recreation facilities.
 - d. No taking pictures or video images around housing when such pictures or images include name identification with rank and address. Non-residents should not be taking photographs in housing areas without prior permission from DPTMS (AT/OPSEC).
 - e. No taking pictures or video images that may be construed as intelligence gathering (1.b.).
6. Permissible imagery collection:
- a. Safety Office, Public Affairs Office (PAO), Directorate of Public Works (DPW), Strategic Communications (STRATCOM) and DPTMS, including Visual Information personnel conducting official duties, are permitted to take photographs, make videos and collect other forms of imagery.
 - b. External media must be escorted by authorized PAO/STRATCOM personnel at all times while visiting POM and OMC. A list of authorized PAO/STRATCOM escorts for media access will be on file with the POM Police and Police Dispatch.
 - c. Service Members and Family Members are permitted to take pictures and videos in and around their immediate quarters. The prohibitions of paragraph 5 apply.
 - d. Those serving and residing at POM and OMC are permitted to take pictures and videos at community events, sporting events, unit organizational functions, family gatherings, ceremonies and at landmark locations such as the Sloat Monument and Berlin Wall Memorial. This includes parents taking photos of their children at CDC/Child Youth School Age Service activities. When hosting guests, POM residents and employees will ensure that this policy is followed.
 - e. Defense Language Institute Foreign Language Center graduation ceremonies, including celebratory photographs and videos in the immediate vicinity of the graduation facility and at locations not excluded in paragraph 5.

f. Questions concerning the permissibility of photography and videography should be directed to the DPTMS Antiterrorism at 831-242-7027 or the Operations Security Officer POM at 831-242-4030.

7. All requests for photography by outside agencies/organizations will be routed by the receiving organization to the Garrison Antiterrorism Officer in DPTMS for appropriate staff actions.

8. Individuals in violation of this policy are subject to immediate questioning as well as confiscation of any notes, photographs, digital imagery, sketches, maps, cameras, photography equipment or other material describing the installation. Violators may also be subject to prosecution under state, federal or military law.
