DLIFLC hosts large cultural event May 11

PRESIDIO OF MONTEREY, Calif. – The Defense Language Institute Foreign Language Center’s annual Language Day Celebration is open to the public this year.

For the first time since 2001, the general public is invited to attend this year’s Language Day celebration. Foreign language education and cultural diversity will be celebrated with displays, activities and performances by instructors and students on the DLIFLC campus at the Presidio of Monterey from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. May 11.

DLIFLC, the largest language institute in the world, has a native-speaking faculty of 2,000. The staff and faculty of DLIFLC come from more than 50 different countries around the world.

The DLIFLC is the Department of Defense’s premier foreign language provider and trains an average of 3,500 military linguists each year in 26 different languages.

Admission is free. Limited parking will be available on the lower Presidio of Monterey, which can be accessed via Artillery Street off of Pacific Street (near Bolio Gate).
