CANCELLED: DLIFLC Language Day

PRESIDIO OF MONTEREY, Calif. – The Defense Language Institute Foreign Language Center’s Language Day, originally scheduled for May 10, has been cancelled for 2013.

This decision was made due to ongoing budgetary uncertainty caused by Sequestration and its effects on the Fiscal Year 2013 DoD Budget.

Cuts to DLIFLC’s operating funds will also limit service member participation in local events that require expenditure of government funds. These measures will most likely last through the end of the fiscal year.
