Presidio Incident ends with no Injuries, Investigation to continue

PRESIDIO OF MONTEREY, Calif. – Today’s exercise on the Presidio was interrupted, and ultimately halted, by what were deemed as credible threats made by an individual toward the installation.

At the time the threats were made, City of Monterey Fire Department and Presidio Police were in a unified command setup for the exercise. They were able to seamlessly transition into the real world situation and begin investigating. This is why we train, to be able to respond to accidents and natural disasters, and to protect the installation and its population.

Law enforcement searched the individual’s vehicle and determined it posed no immediate threat to the safety of the installation.

During this process the Presidio evacuated the immediate vicinity of about 10 buildings and approximately 500 people to another location on the installation.

The incident was declared all clear at 12:47 p.m. As a precaution, Presidio employees were released from the duty day.

At this time the investigation is ongoing.
