**Presidio to conduct
emergency-preparedness training Aug. 7**

PRESIDIO OF MONTEREY, Calif. – The Presidio will conduct a full-scale exercise **Friday, Aug. 7.** This exercise will include activities in the vicinity of Ord Military Community in Seaside.

The scenario will focus on response to a wildland fire on the outskirts Ord Military Community, shelter operations at the General Stilwell Community Center and exercising an electronic family-assistance center.

The wildland fire will be notional only.

Customer-service impacts

As part of the exercise, some staff members from Army Community Service and Child, Youth and School Services will participate.

The ACS and CYSS offices will be staffed and continue to run their administrative functions, but visitors will likely encounter role players or exercise situations on their way to the offices. Additionally, animal-shelter operations will take place at the Doe Park Super Park.

While both venues will remain open for use/business, people are encouraged to plan accordingly and might want to steer clear of both places until noon.
