POM Police respond to shooting in Marshall Park neighborhood

PRESIDIO OF MONTEREY, Calif. – At approximately 12:30 p.m. today Presidio of Monterey Police Department responded to reports of a shooting in the Marshall Park neighborhood of the Ord Military Community.

According to initial investigations by POM PD it appears that a male suspect tried to forcibly enter a home on Kalborn Road. Two related adult males were inside the residence at the time. According to the two residents' statements they did not know or recognize the suspect. One of the residents confronted the suspect trying to enter the home and a physical altercation occurred. Soon after the second resident retrieved a firearm that, at this time, appears to be legally owned and confronted the suspect. According to statements made at the scene, there was a struggle for the weapon between the second resident and the suspect at which point two rounds were fired from the weapon, one of which struck the suspect in the torso.

POM PD arrived to the scene within minutes after receiving notification of the shooting and found the suspect unconscious. They performed life saving measures on the suspect until POM Fire Department and an American Medical Response (AMR) ambulance arrived on scene. The suspect was transferred to Natividad Medical Center in Salinas where he is currently being treated while under POM PD custody.

The resident who fired the shots was taken to the POM police station for further questioning but is not suspected of any crime at this time. The investigation by POM PD is ongoing.
